NSW residents aged 18 years and over can apply for \$100 in vouchers. The vouchers can be used at participating NSW businesses registered as [COVID safe](#).

- 2 x \$25 Dine NSW Vouchers for dining in at restaurants, cafes, bars, wineries, pubs and clubs from Monday to Thursday
- 2 x \$25 Discover NSW Vouchers to be used for entertainment and recreation, including cultural institutions, live music, and arts venues, to use 7 days a week.

The vouchers can't be used on public holidays.

Dine & Discover NSW Vouchers are single use, and cannot be used for tobacco, alcohol or gambling.

Vouchers must be redeemed in person at participating businesses.
