The 11th of April was our 23rd year as a Rotary Club. Things have changed since that date.

We began in a hall at the Leumeah Shopping Centre, but it was sold and closed. We moved then to the Campbelltown Catholic Club and again had to move when it became difficult for the Club to support us. The move from the Catholic Club was up the hill to the Rydges Hotel. Then Rydges decided that they needed to upgrade their premises and we moved again. This time to our present location.

When we began we had 30 members. Half male and half female. Our numbers have changed over the years. Of our Charter members, two, Malcolm and Denys, have remained. Of our present members, two, Rob and Ron have returned. We now have 22 members and of these 12 are female and 10 males. We have kept the balance.

Past members number 93. Regretfully several died. Six moved and joined other clubs and eight were removed for nonattendance.

We have experienced good overseas service working in PNG at Menari to form a school, Kokoda to open the Hospital, Cambodia for Days for Girls and two visits to India as part of Polio Elimination Program.


Coming Up
