### Bread Tags for Wheelchairs – How can I help?

Collecting bread tags enables Aussie Bread Tags to provide wheelchairs that change the life of disabled people in need, as well as keeping the tags out of landfill to help to preserve the environment. It is a community program where individuals and organisations collect bread tags, which are sold to recyclers. The money raised pays for wheelchairs for the less fortunate which are purchased through a local pharmacy. By the start of 2020, Bread Tags for Wheelchairs had funded their 800th wheelchair, which included three funded by Aussie recycling.

Also, one of their biggest challenges at the moment is transport of tags from other states to South Australia. If you have any contacts that may lead to some donated transport, please email aussiebreadtags@gmail.com.
