Polio Free India

Denys went to India to vaccinate children against polio in 2015 and just received an e-mail from the Rotary Club Agra Tajmahal.

Hello Denys, Greetings! We had the pleasure with intensive support in "Keeping India Polio Free Campaigns" from last 2 years in Mega Polio Event 2017 & 2018 with 51 Volunteers from 13 Countries and 63 Volunteers from 17 Countries respectively. Efforts and personal presence who came, made a huge difference in many lives and without them it was impossible to fight on Polio and "Keep India Polio Free"

Our borders are still not sealed and every day we are getting non-immigrants from neighbouring countries and have fear to get Polio back in India, fight against Polio is NOT OVER. We Rotarians ask you as part of one Rotary family to help during next "Mega Polio Campaign 2019" from Jan 4 to 6 2019 at Agra, INDIA.

This year the award went to the Campbelltown Community Safety Officer, Senior Constable David Blom, seen on the left with our Honorary Member and MP, Greg Warren on the right.

The winners from each LAC then go to the Sate function for the overall winner. The 2018 Rotary Police Officer of the Year Awards is the most prestigious event in the NSW Police Force calendar year. This year's event will be held in the Grand Ballroom of the Hyatt Regency, Sydney on Friday 16 November.



Macarthur Sunrise was actively involved with the Chair, from our Club, Cathie Richardson. Cathie, seen in the photo (the left), also made the presentation to the Police Legacy with a cheque for \$6 000 from the night. Also involved with the committee is another of our Members, Wendy Underwood.
