The Western Sydney Rotaract Club have a meeting tonight (Wed 12th). I wish them all the best and I know that Georgia and her team have lots on the agenda,

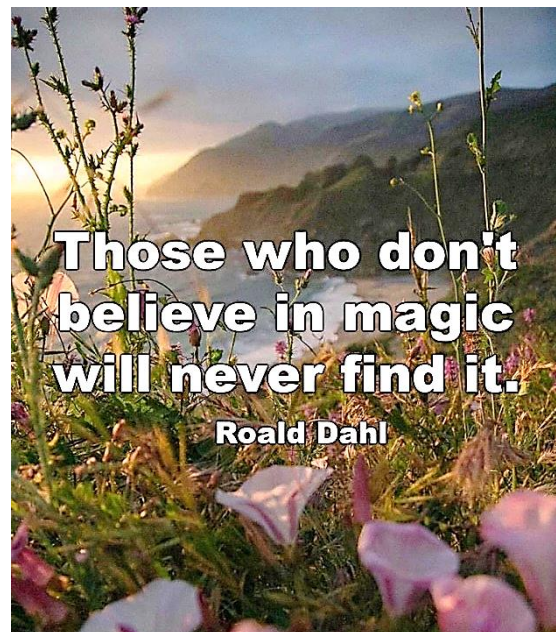
I look forward to helping out and attending their projects. Their youthful enthusiasm is contagious.

This week it's all about the humble ever so nasty straw single use straw.

A recent poll found that an average Australia Pub used an average of 90,000 straws per year. Across the 6,000 pubs in Australia, that's 540 million straws used by pubs alone.

Fast food outlets are an even greater source of unnecessary plastic waste. For example McDonalds Restaurants in Australia serve 1.7 million customers per day in its 900 stores. If only half those customers use a straw (850,000 per day) a frightening 310 million straws per year. JUST from McDonalds!

They end up in land fill, litter parks, road gutters, on beaches, in oceans, in the bellies of wildlife.
